Howard is now Director of PBDE, a private consultancy firm that specialises in events management agency and other work. He has coordinated numerous events since 2003, including the 2017 Pacific Week of Agriculture and the 2019 4th National Arts Festival. He holds dual Masters Degrees in Public Policy and Diplomacy.


### **Shaun Gilchrist**

Jack Loughman is the dynamic General Manager for the Vanuatu Cooperatives Business Network (VCBN). He has a background working in government and as a farmer, and currently represents small business on the Vanuatu Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

VCBN is responsible for empowering Vanuatu's cooperatives including by developing productive market linkages for farm produce. Since the establishment of VCBN, it has become a public agent for all cooperative farmers through the Ministry of Trade and is an effective business link between farmers and the private sector.

Under Jack's leadership, VCBN has recently partnered with Fine Foods Ltd. to process a 100% cold pressed pineapple juice, using organic pineapples from pineapple farmer cooperatives. They are also partnering on "kava juice" – an innovative new product designed and packaged for the export market. Watch out for the new "100% Yumi Coop" brand.

Votausi Mckenzie-Reur is a ground-breaking food entrepreneur and Managing Director of Lapita Café, one of Vanuatu's leading food brands. She recently co-hosted the TV program, Pacific Island Food Revolution.

Votausi is known as "The Queen of Ni- Van Cuisine" and has spent 30 years advocating in Vanuatu for healthy lifestyles including as a home economics secondary school teacher. She has a Masters in nutrition and worked as a National Nutritionist for the Ministry of Health before briefly setting up local restaurant Lapita Cafe.

A true Vanuatu SME trailblazer, Votausi has transformed her small business into a catering company and then expanded it into a major Vanuatu food processing brand producing iconic Vanuatu products such as Lapita Cafe manioc flour, taro chips, tamarind sauce and nangai nut cookies. Her company works on the "farm to table" agritourism model by sourcing local food from a network of over 1,000 farmers, processing, packaging and distributing Lapita Cafe products to consumers and directly to restaurants, resorts and Air Vanuatu.

Glen Craig is the Chairperson of the Vanuatu Business Resilience Committee and Managing Partner of specialist business advisory firm, Pacific Advisory.

Pacific Advisory is the largest South Pacific based consultancy and provides a broad range of advisory, consulting and strategic services to Governments, financial institutions, corporates, regional agencies and institutional investors in the region.
