1. Sort (Seiri)

☑ Eliminate all unnecessary items

[Unnecessary items are those which are not required for current work

Classify items on priority, frequency of use and storage method



- Take before & after photos
- Set a completion deadline
- *Red tag* potential items to remove





2. Set in order (Seiton)

☑ Identify tasks & critical equipment

Design a functional layout

☑ Label all facilities so anyone can easily find and use them



- Use Visuals ... signs, labels, images & simple colour coding
- Eliminate all unnecessary items
- Identify & mark any hazards





3. Shine (Seiso)

 \square Clean everything

Establish cleaning schedules

☑ Establish cleaning SOPs



 Paint walls and surfaces in colours that show dirt so you can see more easily when it needs cleaning





- 4. Standardise (Seiketsu)
- ☑ Document SOPs
- \square Enforce the SOPs
- ☑ Investigate inconsistencies




- Investigate any inconsistencies and variations to eliminate deviation from the standard
- Control what happens, when it happens & how it happens




- 5. Sustain (Shitsuke)
- ☑ Maintain 5 'S' discipline
- Continuously improve systems
- ☑ Apply metric to measure success




• Try to find fun ways to keep 5'S' alive (e.g. weekly team activities)


